“A community of practice is a group of people who share a common concern, a set of problems, or interest in a topic and who come together to fulfil both individual and group goals ”.

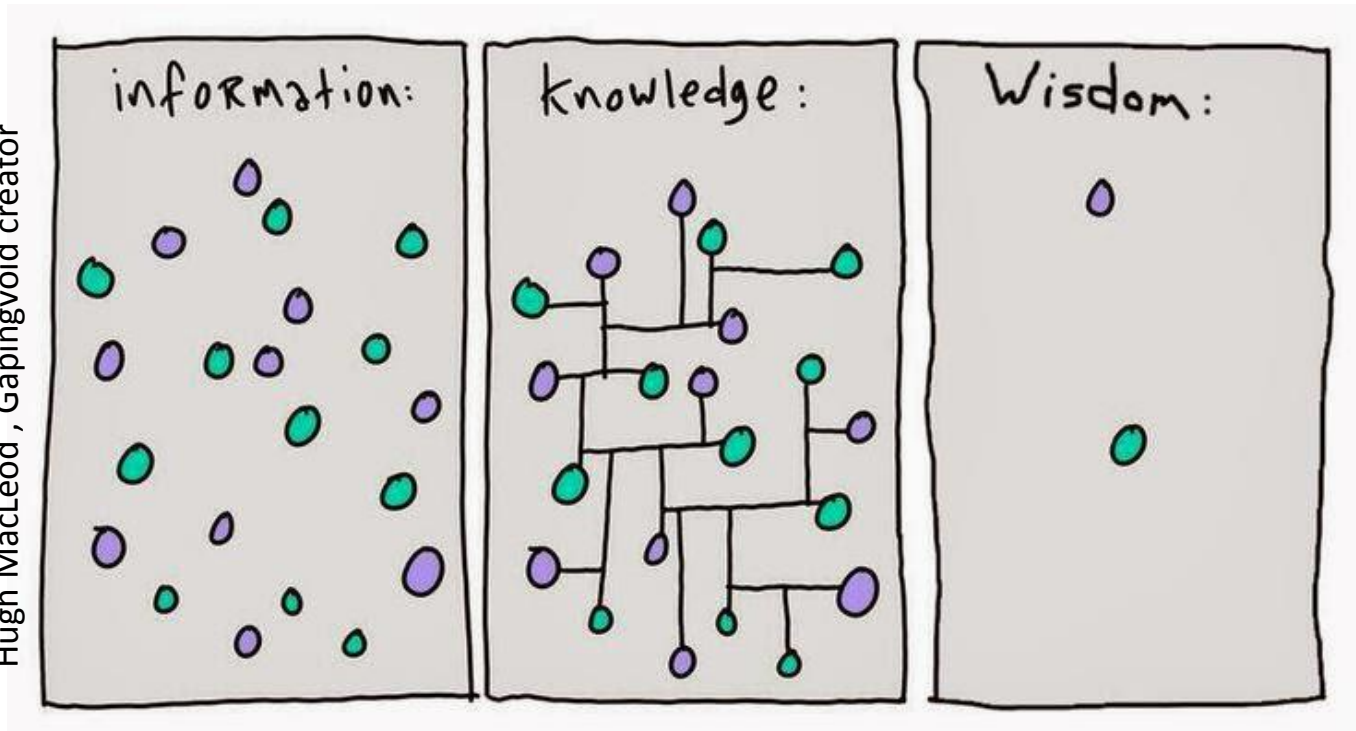

Generate new knowledge

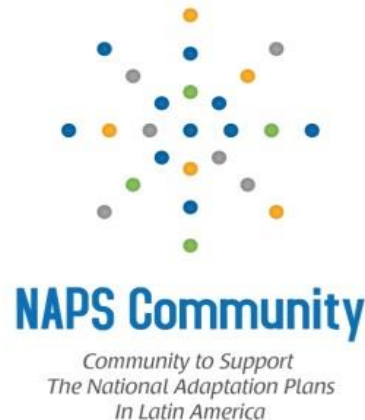
Introduce collaborative processes
